



#### What to prepare

- Paper that is somewhat thick
- Scissors, cutter • Cutter mat
- Ruler • Pencil • Tweezers
- Ballpoint pen that can no longer write, or stylus
- Adhesive (strong adhesive is recommended)
- String

#### Assembly procedure

1. Print out the parts pages with a printer.
2. Before cutting a part, write its part number on the back of it with a pencil.
3. Before cutting a part, use a ballpoint pen that can no longer write, or a stylus, to trace along its fold lines and make creases.
4. Cut out the part along the cut-out line.
5. Fold the dotted line according to the instructions for mountain-folding and valley-folding.
6. Glue and assemble the various parts according to the illustrations.

#### Explanation of symbols

- |                    |                   |                            |                           |                                   |

| Cut-out line       | Slit-cutting line | Cut-through                | Glue                      | Glue to the front of another part |
| Mountain fold line | Valley fold line  | <b>1,2...</b> Part numbers | Glue within the same part | Glue to the back of another part  |

#### Notes

- When using scissors, cutters, adhesives, etc. that may be dangerous to infants, keep them out of infants' reach.
- When using scissors or a cutter, be careful not to cut your fingers, etc.
- Be careful not to get injured by the cross section or edge of the paper.

**1** Assembly of "\*"   
 Glue the area indicated with "\*" on the part within the same part. Assemble all other parts marked with "\*" in the same way.

**7** \* The required string length may vary depending on the assembly method. Assemble while adjusting the string length, using the length shown in the figure as a guide.

Tie the string into a loop, then insert and glue the center of the string with Part 21.

\* Assemble in sequence starting from "a".

Hook the string on Part 27.

\* Assemble in sequence starting from "a".

**9**

Hook the string on Part 24.

Tie the string into a loop, then insert with Part 29 and 30. Hook the string on Part 24 and glue Part 29 and 30 to the body.
